The Contemporary European Studies Association of Australia (CESAA) and the European Union Centre at RMIT are pleased to invite you to this public seminar on the Brexit crisis.

Not surprisingly, the fragility of trade relations is at the heart of the Brexit crisis: the 'backstop' is precisely about the protection of just one dimension of this. However, the struggle over the United Kingdom's referendum on leaving the European Union is symptomatic of much deeper crises in the UK, and also in the EU.

This seminar by Professor Bruce Wilson will focus on the ways in which the Brexit episode derives from and reveals these crises. While this seminar will occur four days after that supposed date of departure, the UK is in fact unlikely to leave the EU on 29 March 2019. This very uncertainty demonstrates the depth of crisis, but also carries within the seeds for some optimism about how these crises might be resolved.
