Dr Gabriele Suder is Director of the International CEO Forum, and expert at the OECD (Services Competitiveness), the EU, JETRO and for the Australian Government (Commonwealth and State level). She is Vice President of the Australia New Zealand International Business Academy (ANZIBA). Gabriele has served as Professor and Professorial Fellow at The University of Melbourne. She was active member of the Centre for Asian Business and Economics (CABE) and served most recently also on the Steering Committee of the EU Centre on Shared Complex Challenges. Prior to this, Gabriele served as Director, International Relations at The University of Melbourne and as Jean Monnet Chair and Professor at SKEMA Business School in France, China and the USA.

Gabriele is a distinguished, award-winning, highly prolific author, with more than 50 peer-reviewed scholarly journal articles and 11 books. They include *International Business, Doing Business in Europe, The Routledge Companion to European Business* (co-edited and co-authored) and a book series on the impact of terrorism on internationalisation, and *Doing Business in Asia*. Gabriele is Editorial Board member at *The Journal of International Business Policy* and *The International Business Review*. She has published more than 70 corporate and sector case studies. Most recently, she has published the Sage Case studies "Airbus: Brexit and the trans-European business catalyst" and "The internationalisation of Redbubble: E-Privacy impacts on a Third-Party marketplace strategy".
