



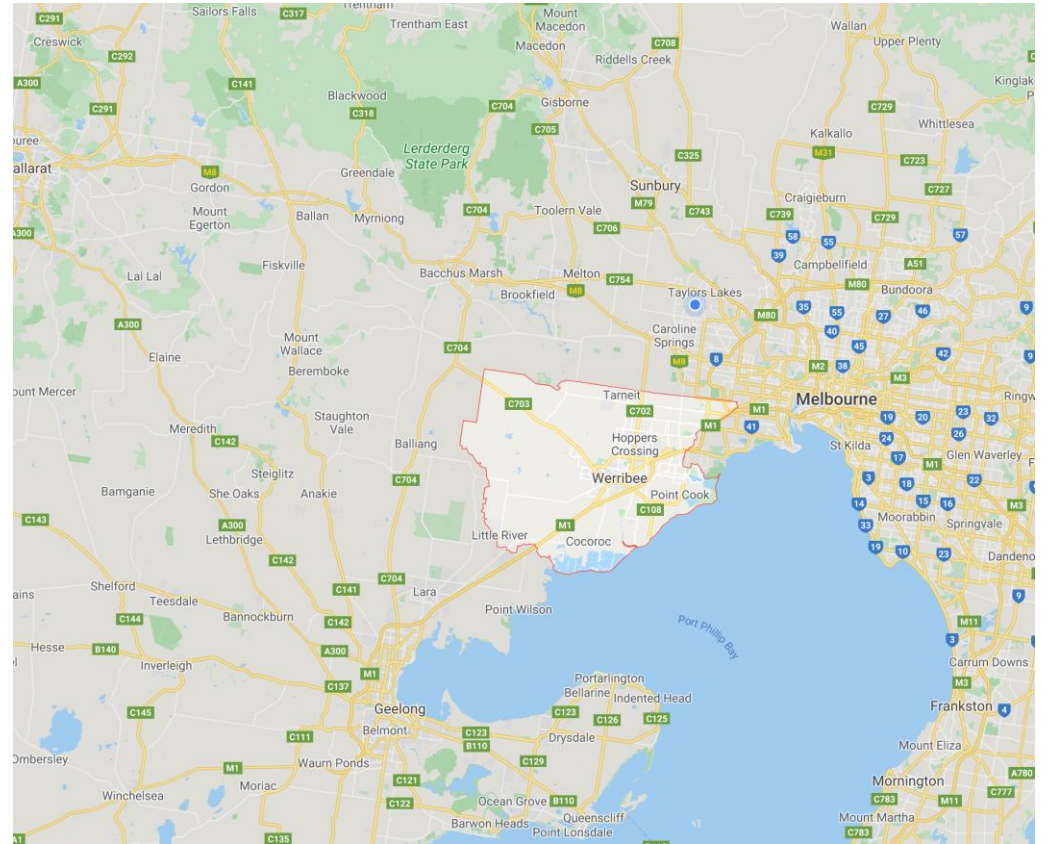

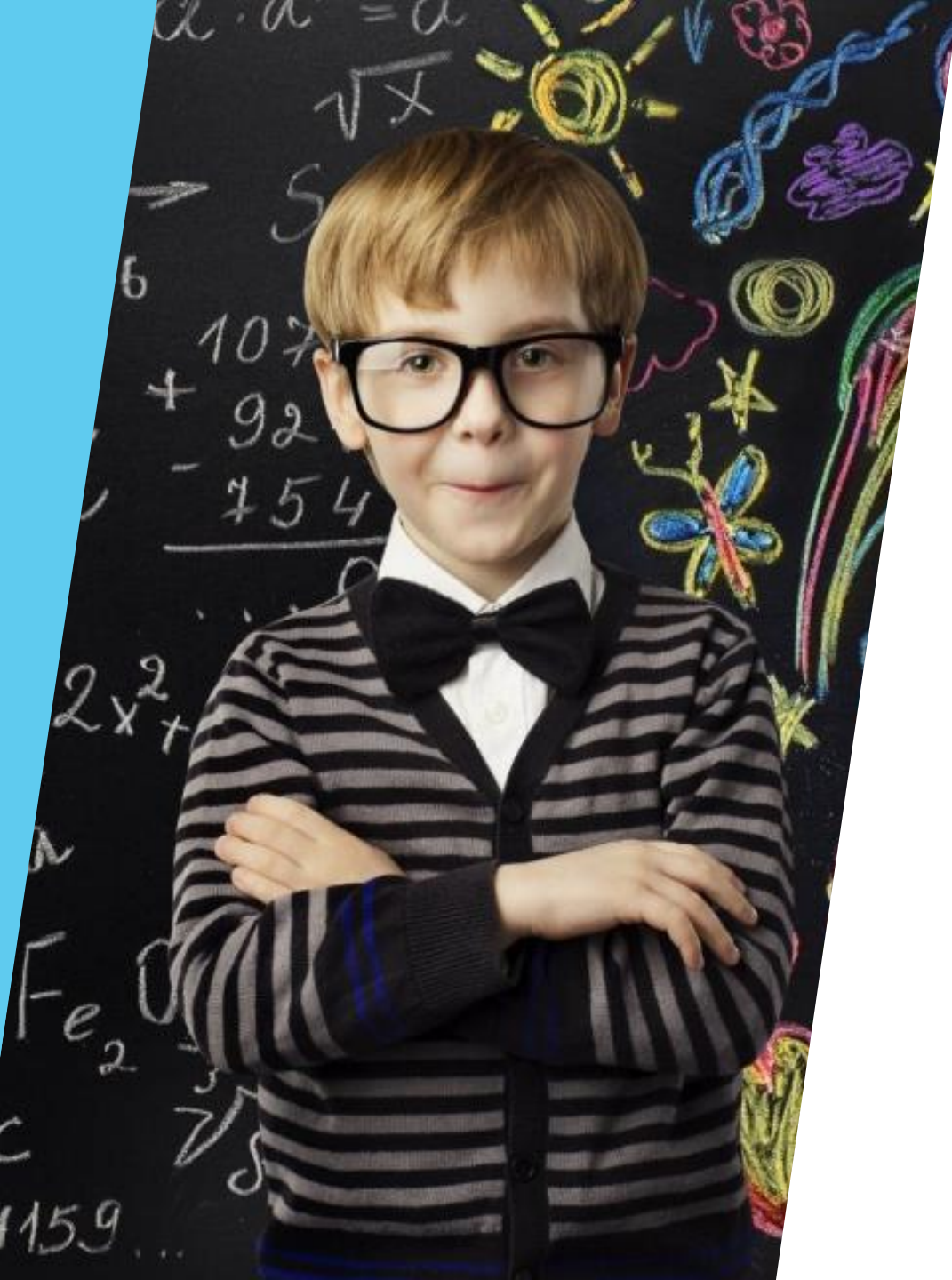

Snapshot: Wyndham's Workforce

- 62% employed outside the city
- 21.3% employed at a location within the Melbourne CBD, with a large proportion working in jobs which require a tertiary qualification
- 5% employed in the Financial & Insurances sector. 91% of these people work outside the city
- 6.5% employed in the Professional & Scientific Services sector. 80% of these people work outside Wyndham
- 44.3% hold a diploma, advanced diploma, bachelor or higher degree, only marginally less than Victoria's 44.8%
