What?

How?

You can approach your National Agency and discuss possible support measures, and you can discuss how to finance your participation in your organisation or in your community networks.

The conference is free of charge and Catalonia can offer you low budget travel and accommodation.

Before, during and after the conference you will be invited to use and discuss the outcomes of the Xploit project, offering a wide range of learning community approaches, inspiration and practical cases from very different working communities from across Europe.

Active participation will enable you to take new and valuable steps in your community and to play a key role in the future of your community.
